Bharat Scouts and Guides

Introduction

The Bharat Scouts & Guides is an inclusive educational initiative for youth, operating on a voluntary and non-partisan basis, welcoming individuals of all backgrounds without discrimination based on origin, race, or belief. It follows the vision, principles, and methodologies established by its founder, Lord Baden Powell, in 1907.

Objective

The aim of the movement is to foster the comprehensive growth of young individuals, enabling them to realize their complete physical, intellectual, emotional, social, and spiritual capabilities. This development empowers them to become responsible citizens and active contributors to their local, national, and global communities.

Scouting in India

- In 1909, Captain T.H. Baker laid the foundation for Scouting in India by establishing the first Scout Troop in Bangalore, registered with the Imperial Headquarters in London. Subsequently, Scout Troops emerged in Kirkee (Pune), Shimla, Madras, Jabalpur, and Lonavla (Mumbai) in 1910 and 1911. Initially, these units were accessible only to European and Anglo-Indian children.
- The first Guide Company in India was established in Jabalpur, Central India, in 1911.
- Due to the exclusion of Indian boys from the Scout Movement initially, Indian nationalist leaders took the initiative to provide Scouting opportunities to them. The Sewa Samiti Scout Association was founded in Allahabad by Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya, Pandit Hriday Nath Kunzru, and Pandit Sriram Bajpai. Additionally, Dr. Annie Besant, with the assistance of Shri G.S. Arundale, established a separate Scout Association for Indian Boys in Madras.
- Attempts were made to unify the various Scout groups in India during Lord Baden Powell's visits in 1921 and 1937 but were unsuccessful. The primary obstacle to unification was the inclusion of the phrase "Duty to King" in the promise clause. Indian nationalist leaders objected to pledging allegiance to the British Empire and insisted that loyalty to the country should be part of the Scout Promise instead.
