A Profile of the College

Govt. Degree College, Arki came into being on 6th July, 1994. Since its inception, the college has riser from strength to strength and has progressively made its mark as one of the leading institution of higher learning in Himachal Pradesh. This co-educational institute provides an ideal ambience to the students for pursuit of learning and development of personality. The college is affiliated to the Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla under sections 2(f) and 12 (B) of UGC act and has been accredited B'Grade by NAAC. The college offers different undergraduate programs in humanities, science (Medical and Nor Medical) and commerce. We also have a course of Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA) and Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Applications (PGDCA) being run under self-financing scheme. All these courses confirm to the Choice Based Credit System of RUSA. The college has evolved as a fountain-head of learning providing quality education to students of the Arki region, which is primarily a rural area. It has adequate infrastructure in terms of classrooms, laboratories, library, computer lab with Wi-Fi connection and modern facilities and a playground, etc. It has separate Arts, Science and Administrative Blocks. We also provide the facility of smart classrooms and Wi-fi to students on the Campus.

Utkrisht Mahavidyalaya Yojna

The Govt. College Arki is proud to be included under Utkrisht Mahavidyalaya Yojana of the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh during the session 2021-2022. Under Utkrisht Mahavidyalaya Yojana the college has received a grant of Rs 1 Crore in Feb. 2022 which was utilized for up gradation of academic, cultural, sports infrastructure besides creation of smart and virtual classrooms and digital studio and video conferencing room.

In sports the college decided to create a basket ball court and an open air gym on the campus. In cultural infrastructure, the college decided to create an audio-visual room and purchased public address system, speakers, mikes, collar mikes and musical instruments. The college also decided to install a statue of the Saraswati, the goddess of knowledge and learning at the threshold of the college building. For academic up gradation, the college decided to create a highly modern career placement and guidance cell along with English language laboratory and a computational physics lab and a centre for multidisciplinary research with all smart facilities.

Under Utkrisht Mahavidyalaya Yojana the college also allocated funds for complete digitalization of the office work including online fee collection, conduct of exams, digital notice board, digital record and elibrary.

In addition to academic and cultural infrastructure, the college utilize the funds for renovation of college gate, porch and other minor tasks.
