A Report

NSS UNIT of G.C. Arki organised a special seven days camp at Batal Village from 23rd December 2023 to 29th December 2023. This camp was organised on the theme “Educated Youth and Self-Reliant India”. In this camp 64 volunteers participated. The camp was inaugurated by the chief guest Prof. Sunita Sharma, Principal G.C. Arki. She congratulated the units and gave her best wishes and assured co-operation during the camp. She also congratulated volunteers for getting this unique opportunity for community services. Dr. Manju Lata Sharma, Associate Professor of Chemistry was special guest in this function. She shared her experiences of student life and encouraged volunteers to get success in life. In the inaugural session volunteers also presented cultural items like Dance, Gidda and songs. N.S.S. programme officer Dr. Dhan Dev Sharma laid out the report of previous activities and apprised the schedule and daily routine of volunteers during the camp. N.S.S. programme officer Ms. Suman Kumari proposed vote of thanks. After the lunch, programme officer addressed the assembly of volunteers and classified the volunteers in groups. In the evening volunteers were directed to perform any cultural activity to overcome stage fear.

Second day, after the breakfast volunteers went to college campus where they carried out extensive labour work to develop the Pushp Vatika. After Lunch an academic session was scheduled in which Mr. Rohit ji, Social activist and influencer was invited as resource person and delivered a lecture on “Importance of time in the life of students”. In evening volunteers also had sports activities and cultural activities.

On Third Day, volunteers cleaned the wild shrubs behind the college building and cleared the boundary and path corridor. After the Lunch, Dr. Dhan Dev Sharma, NSS P.O. discussed the importance of social service in the life of students. He also shared his life experiences as NSS volunteer.

On Fourth Day, after morning assembly and Yoga session, volunteers were practiced special meditation techniques by the programme officer. After taking breakfast all volunteers moved to village where they worked with villagers to clean surroundings of temple and public water resource. In the evening, they interacted with senior fellows, retired persons of the village who shared the teaching of their life.

On the Fifth Day, all the volunteers carried out an awareness rally from college campus to Batal Chowk. During the rally volunteers voiced slogans to sensitize the masses about environment conservation and drug abuse. After the lunch, an academic session was organised as usual. In this session Advocate Neelam Sharma was invited as resource person. She spoke on the “Woman harassment issues at work place and sexual abuse in the society. The session was interactive in which volunteers participated actively and asked many questions and got clarity over their doubts.

On the sixth day, all the volunteers went to Batal village Prangan, where they presented a Nukkadd natak aimed to give the message to respect wild fallow animals especially stray cow and stray dogs. After the lunch, volunteers had an academic session in which members of Old Student Association and ex-NSS president of the college unit were present as resource person. They apprised

the volunteers about the contemporary experiences of the camp. They also talked about the positive personality changes experienced due to being volunteer of NSS.

On the Last day, volunteers started their preparation for valedictory session. In the valedictory session, Prof. Sunita Sharma was the chief guest. She congratulated the entire team of NSS for successful culmination of the camp. She re-affirmed that the work done by the volunteers during the camp will imprint great learning in the life of volunteers and the same will reflect in their personality.
